Donations directly support the purchase of new equipment and extra items which we would not otherwise be able to afford. Recent donations have funded:

Compression pumps for local cancer patients



Donations to our Focus fund have enabled home treatment for people suffering from Lymphoedema, a condition common among cancer patients. The compression pumps reduce swelling through fluid build-up.

Jaundice meters to safeguard newborn babies



Newborn babies can often have jaundice, which may be temporary but can potentially be a more serious condition. It's important that we find out the cause as quickly as possible. Donations have funded life-saving machines called Jaundice Meters which enable our community midwife team to test the blood of new babies, helping us to quickly identify and treat serious illnesses.

New hoist to help patients regain mobility



A former patient on Dixon Ward donated £1,000 to enable the team to purchase a piece of equipment that helps aid mobility. After sustaining a lower leg injury, Susan found the Sara Steady Hoist she used to be such a useful piece of equipment that she decided to fund the purchase of a second hoist to benefit future patients on the ward.
