

# Operating your Radio

Listening to the radio stations couldn't be easier! All you need to do is use the same handset that you use to call the nurse, and listen in with the headphones provided behind your bed.

## Call button

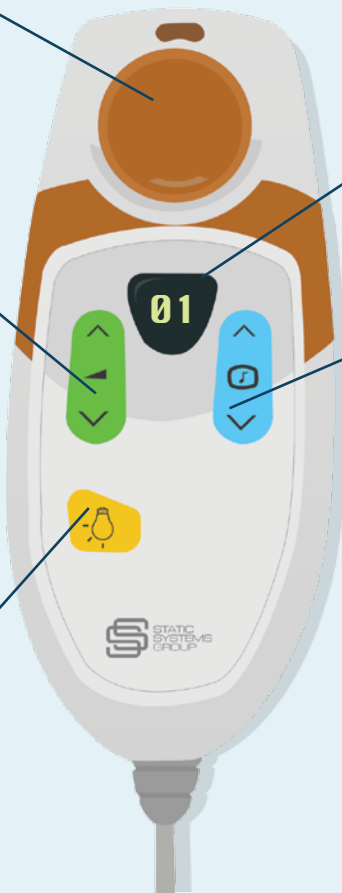
Press the large orange button to call for the nurse's assistance.

## Volume Control

Use the up and down arrows on the left of your handset to adjust the headset volume to a comfortable level.

## Light

Operates your bed's reading light.
