

# The Safety Concern

- Newly Qualified International Nurses had Unexplainable delays in achieving core competencies specific to ward area.
- Waste of skills
- Impact on Nurses Confidence in doing the Job
- Patient safety



### The Aim

 For newly qualified international Nurses, to increase the competency achievement level by 30% within 12 months of gaining registration within wards 4b, 6b, 9A and FAS

#### Outcome:

After introduction of booklet we did another survey on new cohort of international nurses, to measure the effectiveness - 14 participants out of 20 came back and said they used the booklet as a guideline to achieve their competency and they were successful in it- which was 70%



#### **Process**

• Initial survey on **20 participants** from four wards to test their thoughts on competency achievement within 6 months' time frame and a booklet introduction- 100percent had trouble in achieving the competencies.


- Regular meetings with the ward managers who took the booklet to test in their areas which were our base wards to start with.
- Final survey after trial of booklet on 20 new participants of international nurses



## Balancing Measures


- Staff being able to put forward for training by mentors
- Quarterly Review by mentors on achieving competencies by the candidates.
- Staff being able to identify the required specific competencies





#### Results of First Survey








Develop and introduce a booklet including ward specific core competencies and time frame to achieve it.

20 international nurses were included in questionnaire and zero had awareness on what are the core competencies how to achieve them




Aiming for international nurses to achieve core competencies without delay from start of employment

Revised booklet and re introduced for 6-12 months

Overall positive feedback from managers and international Nurses. However competencies needed relooking specific for medical division




Three months trial of the booklet

**Evaluate booklet Outcome** 



Embedded in departments and aim to circulate trust wide in the next 12 months

Result showed participants achieved 70% of the competencies in required time frame




6-12 months trial of the booklet
