



Gloucestershire Wound Management Formulary 2024

The Wound Care Formulary was compiled by representatives from Gloucestershire Health and Care NHS Trust, Gloucestershire Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust. Together NHS Foundation Trust and the Gloucestershire Integrated Care Board. It was a multidisciplinary group made up of registered nurses (including tissue viability specialist nurses), podiatrists, financial accountants as well as procurement and administrative support team members. Advice was given to the group by pharmacists and a Nurse Specialist working at the Gloucestershire Integrated Care Board.



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Introduction

This formulary content is a revised edition for 2022, The lay out has been updated in 2024. It is based on the previous formulary, which was developed by The County Wide Tissue Viability Steering Group comprising of representatives from Gloucestershire Health Care (GHC) and Gloucestershire Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust. This formulary has been reviewed by multidisciplinary professionals representing all Gloucestershire Health Providers.

Our aims are towards:

- Promoting rational prescribing.
- Supporting the practical application of nurse prescribing.
- Encouraging safe, effective and appropriate use of dressings.
- Cost effectiveness.

These formulary choices are based on performance and stability of both the item and the manufacturing / supplying company, as well as consideration of price.

Please order the exact amount of dressings required, and **not** necessarily the listed pack size. Supplier details and contact numbers can also be obtained from the BNF. Multi Compression bandaging should be ordered following your current protocol.

Amber	2nd Line: Available after consultation with a Specialist Nurse/Team or Tissue Viability Nurse. Would a less expensive item suffice?
Red	Hospital or Specialist use only – Podiatry, Complex Leg Wound Service, Lymphoedema and Tissue Viability. A high-cost item.
